Lion Tamer

The Lion Tamer ensures that all necessary items and the room are set up properly so the meeting can run smoothly.

In this role, he/she serves as the custodian of all club property and paraphernalia. This includes flags, banners, gong, gavel, podium, song books and any other items designated by the club. He/She is responsible for putting each item in its proper place prior to the meeting and then returning said items for proper storage after the meeting.

Maintaining club property/paraphernalia also falls to the Lion Tamer. This could include everything from sewing new patches on the club banner to replacing worn club signage on your community's welcome sign to ordering a new gavel.

The Lion Tamer also acts as the club's Sergeant-at-Arms, ensuring that all present are properly seated and distributes any literature/bulletins during the meeting.

He/She should also do what they can to ensure new members/guests are made to feel welcome and introduced to other club members.

As the Lion Tamer, you will also serve as a full member of your club's board of directors, attending and participating in all regular and special board meetings.
